

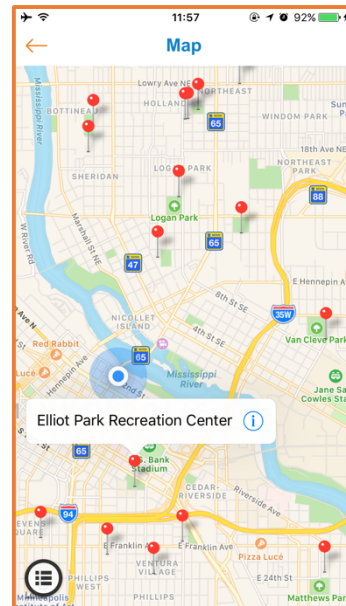
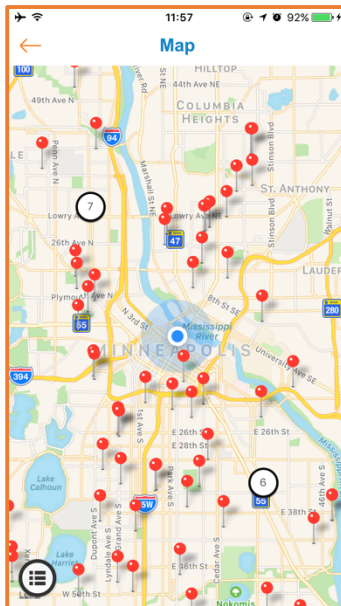


For smartphone users (*easiest and best way to locate free summer meals*)

- Search “**Summer Eats Minnesota**” in Apple App Store or Google Play Store and download the free app to find the nearest site serving meals. The app can also be shared via email and social media. Powered by GPS, it shows locations of summer food sites, their menus and days and hours of operation. Kids 18 and under can show up without prior signup for free meals at these locations, which include parks, recreation and community centers, libraries and schools. The app shows the distance and directions to the nearest sites.

For non-smartphone users

- Contact someone who has a smartphone and ask them to download **Summer Eats Minnesota app**. Use the app’s map function located on the launch page to find the nearest serving sites.



- Visit **USDA’s website** and search “**Summer Food Rocks**”, use **summer meal map** at <https://www.fns.usda.gov/summerfoodrocks> and find a serving site near you.
- Text “**Food**” to **877-877** and you will be texted a response message asking for address or zip code. Three meal serving sites near the address or zip code provided will be texted.
- Use **United Way hotline**: dial 211 move through prompts to speak to a person who can provide you with serving site information.
- Use **USDA hotline**: call 1-866-3-hungry (1-866-348-6479).
